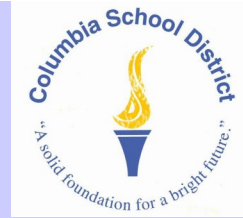

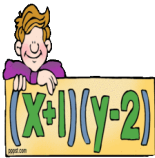
Classes located at Columbia Central Jr. High

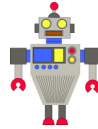
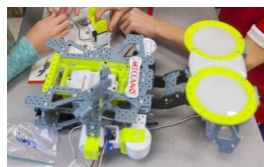
