Guidelines are as follows:

-  Original: All work must be completed by an individual student
-  Size: No larger than 12 inches x 18 inches
-  Format: Must be two-dimensional art
-  Medium: Any medium may be used (crayon, pencil, watercolor, oil, collage, digital
format, cray-pas or others)

Posters will be on display in each building and a “Students’ Choice” Award will be selected by popular vote. The winning artwork from each building will be on display at CCHS during the Winter Basketball Homecoming on January 20, 2017.

All work must be submitted by Friday, December 16, 2016. Elementary entries should be submitted to the classroom teacher and secondary entries should be turned in to the building secretary by the end of the school day. The student’s name, grade and teacher (for elementary students) must be clearly written on the back of the poster.
